February 22, 2020: Day in the Studios, All artwork must be delivered to the Parkersburg Art Center, 8:30-noon

(or previously mailed flat to Katy Crim Robert C. Byrd High School, One Eagle Way, Clarksburg, WV 26301)

February 29, 2020: Portfolio Reviews 10-noon

2-D and 3-D awards ceremony for students: 1pm

February 29, 2020: Award presentation at 1 p.m.

April 17,2020: Arts Alive showcase 6pm

*NEW VENUE:, Charleston Culture Center, Capitol Complex -- Pick up after the finale 8:30pm

***Increased Awards package:

2-D & 3-D Exhibit Awards: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for each category of High School, Middle School and Elementary.

Art and Technology Award: \$100.00 awarded to the best photography or computer-generated image, sponsored by the West Virginia Art Education Association.

West Virginia Watercolor Society Award: \$100.00 awarded to the student of the best of the watercolor artworks entered.

Sargent Awards: The Sargent awards are COMBINED for both 2-D and 3-D Exhibits and will be presented on stage at Arts Alive to each student and teacher:

1st Place Overall Best of Show \$500 Check from WVAEA

(\$500 in supplies to the student, \$1,000 in supplies to the teacher,),

one overall High School Award (\$400art supplies for student and teacher)

\$100 check from WVAEA

one overall Middle School Award (\$400 art supplies for student and teacher)

\$100 check from WVAEA

one overall Elementary School Award. (\$400 art supplies for student and teacher)

\$100 check from WVAEA

Eligibility: Each of the 55 counties in West Virginia may submit NINE works: 1 watercolor, 1 digital, 3 sculptures/3-D, 4 2-D works

artworks completed by any WV K-12 students during the current academic year are eligible. It is up to your county to decide how to choose/judge artwork for your county's exhibit.

Originality: Artwork must be original in content. No copies of photos or other artists' work. No use of stock photos as references.

Entry Fee: \$10 for non-members. This defrays the costs for mileage for the coordinator, award ribbons, matting & display supplies.

2-D Matting: Please send your county's artwork ready for display with a 2" matted border. It is up to your county to decide how to mat your county's art. If the submissions are matted poorly, they may be re-matted

Size limitations:

2-D submissions shall be no larger than 24" \times 36." If submissions are larger, then it is the responsibility of the teacher to transport item to and from competitions at Parkersburg and Charleston.

3-D submissions shall be no heavier than 40 lbs. and should be portable for one person to handle. If submissions are larger, then it is the responsibility of the teacher to transport item to and from competitions at Parkersburg and Charleston.

Entry Forms:

Please fill out the entry form <u>completely</u> and include **3 copies** of the entry form with your submissions. Please type or print clearly. Entry forms can be printed from the WVAEA Website. We can only contact winners if we have this information.

Labeling Submissions:

- 2-D: Securely tape a copy of the entry form to the back of the artwork.
- 3-D: Securely roll or tape a copy of the entry form to the inside or bottom of the artwork.

Disclaimer: We make every effort to handle the artwork with care. The WVAEA will not be held accountable for damaged or lost artwork during the mailing process, display, and handling. Please ensure your submissions are labeled securely and are sturdy enough for handling through the display process.

Return of Submissions: pick up is at the conclusion of the Arts Alive Showcase April 17, 2020, no earlier than 8:30 pm. The 2-D exhibit will travel from the Parkersburg Art Center to the Charleston Culture Center in Charleston for the WVDE Arts Alive Showcase on April 17, 2020. It is the responsibility of your county to make arrangements for pick-up of your county's exhibit submissions. Please have a County Representative present at Arts Alive to sign out the artwork and return it to the county.

*If this is impossible works may be shipped to you but you must pre-pay for shipping and make prior arrangements with the YAM coordinator: Katy Crim, kcrim@k12.wv.us

Submissions that have been left behind after Arts Alive without having made prior return arrangements will not be returned.
